- All entries need to be **2 dimensional (2D)** and suitable to be wall-mounted. This can include paintings, drawings and collages.
- The size of the artwork should be **minimum A4 and maximum A3**
- There will be 4 age-groups: **3 - 4 years, 5-7 years, 8 - 11 years, 12+ years**

There will be a display of the winning entries during September & October

Entries to be submitted by Saturday 5th September 2020

1. The Christian Heritage Centre Art Competition is organised by the Christian Heritage Trust, Bell End, Rowley Regis.
2. The competition is open to all ages and experience.
3. One entry per person.
4. Works should be a minimum of A4 and maximum of A3 in size.
5. All entries must be the sole work of the artist and unpublished at the time of submission to the competition. Please be aware that online images can be copied by anyone viewing the website. We cannot accept any liabilities for any damages that arise.
6. The judge will be nominated by the Christian Heritage Trust.
7. Judging of the competition will be completed by 14th September 2020. Winners/schools will be contacted and named for each age group. Prizes will be awarded for each category and the work included in a display. The Christian Heritage Trust reserves the right not to award any or all of the prizes.
8. Copyright of the winning entries will rest with the artist. However entry into the competition will permit unrestricted, unaccredited use of the images by the Christian Heritage Centre for promotional purposes.
9. All competition entries must be received by Mrs A Burrows, at 27, Beauty Bank, Cradley Heath, West Midlands B64 7HZ by **Saturday 5th September 2020**. Entries can be received anytime up to that date and must be clearly marked 'Art Competition.'
10. The Christian Heritage Centre does not accept liability for the loss or damage to any entries. Proof of posting is not proof of delivery.
11. The Christian Heritage Centre is unable to return any pictures submitted for this competition to individuals; however pictures will be returned to schools or will be available for collection during November or December. Please ring in advance to arrange collection - 01384-637314
